Both regions celebrated great vintages in 2015 with excellent growing conditions.



Provence enjoys over 3,000 hours of sunshine a year. The Mediterranean climate is cooled by sea breezes and sheltered from the extremes of the Mistral wind by rolling hills, providing ideal conditions for viticulture. The Pfalz region in Germany is warm and dry, and its rising prominence has led to many dubbing the area the 'Tuscany of Germany'. The region excels in Pinot Noir and the Villa Wolf Pinot Noir rosé is no exception. The Pfalz is still relatively unknown, and many of their wines remain excellent value for money!

This is our most popular Provençal rosé, and is made by family winemakers Ravoire et Fils. Les Soleillades is a traditional Provençal blend of Grenache and Cinsault with a small addition of Syrah. A pale salmon pink in colour with aromas of raspberry, quince, wild strawberry and a hint of honeysuckle. On

the palate juicy summer fruit flavours combine with red cherry and a hint of ripe peach on the finish. A dry, fruity wine with a refreshing finish. Enjoy with summer salads, stuffed vegetables or parma ham. Drink now until 2017+.



Villa Wolf is acclaimed Mosel winemaker, Ernst Loosen's venture in the warmer climes of the Pfalz region, Germany. Under the guidance of Dr Loosen since 1996, the estates quality and reputation today is a return to the glories of 1843, when its Italianate estate house was constructed. From

vineyards farmed expressly for the purpose of producing rosé, this 100% Pinot Noir is light and elegant, refreshing and dry. Fruity notes of cranberry and raspberry persist with a clean, zippy finish. Enjoy now until 2017+. An excellent food match with delicate seafood.



William Chase is the entrepreneur behind Tyrrells crisps and Chase Distillery. Starting life as a potato farmer he has now lent his agricultural hand to winemaking. William brought Château Constantin - located just north of Aix-en-Provence - in 2012. This seductive rosé comes from vines planted in the

1960's, which are nursed by the sunny climate and cooling winds. Crisp, fresh and fruity with notes of white peach, grapefruit and strawberry. The palate has a gorgeously full and textured weight with a long, clean finish. Enjoy with camembert and light bites.
