

RED WINES (Continued)**SL46067 Vina Montes Alpha Pinot Noir 2013, Leyda Valley 14% 11.95**

The Leyda Valley is a small sub-region of the San Antonio Valley wine region, 55 miles west of Santiago. Enjoying the cooling effects of the Humboldt current, the region can produce excellent Pinot Noir. This fine example was part aged in French oak for 12 months; adding weight, structure and complexity to the wine. Floral notes mingle with strawberry on the nose; the palate is soft and rounded with a fresh, clean finish. Enjoy with roast pork. Drink now until 2018+.

**SL44344 Vina Ventisquero Grey Cabernet Sauvignon 2012, Maipo Valley 14% 13.49**

The Maipo Valley is the closest Chilean wine region to Santiago, and is best known for its Cabernet Sauvignon. The Ventisquero Grey Cabernet Sauvignon is aged 18 months in oak barrels before spending additional time in bottle before release. Attractive fruit aromas of blackcurrant, raspberry and cranberry marry with hints of pepper and vanilla spice. On the palate, generous berry fruit flavours with hints of mocha envelope a rich, textured mouthfeel. An impressively long, layered finish with fine acidity and chocolatey tannins. Best decanted carefully prior to serving. Pair with roast beef. Enjoy until 2019.

Chile is often quoted as being a wine maker's paradise. Low costs, dependable weather and lack of pests and diseases make it a source of envy for much of the Old World. These factors combined with a plentiful supply of snow melt from the Andes as a regular supply of water, have allowed Chile to become one of the finest sources of well-priced, excellent quality varietal wines, adored for their ripe, fruity and generous character.

Vines were first planted in Chile by Spanish Conquistadores in the mid-16th Century. However the French varietals which dominate the winemaking landscape today were first introduced by Don Silvestre Ochagavia Echazarreta, returning from his studies in Europe. The vines adapted easily to Chile's climate and soils and today they are thought to be one of the few pre-phylloxera clones existing in the world. Chile's return to democracy in the early 1990s fuelled economic growth which has enabled the Chilean wine industry to flourish in the modern world. The industry is now maturing, and as more attention is paid to matching grape varieties to location, we believe the wines of Chile are getting better and better!

WHITE WINE**SL47291 Los Boldos Momentos Chardonnay 2015, Casablanca Valley 13.5% 7.99**

The fruit for this wine comes from the Casablanca valley; located approximately 1 hour west of Santiago. This area benefits from cool Pacific Ocean breezes and is known for its fresh whites. The 2015 is bright greenish yellow in the glass, hinting at fresh citrus fruit. This is confirmed by the nose, which adds subtle green apple, pear and honey characters. Crisp acidity segues into a delicately buttery finish. An excellent match for fish pie and fish cakes. Drink now until 2018+.

SL45762 Vina Ventisquero Clasico Sauvignon Blanc 2014, Central Valley 12% 7.99

Vina Ventisquero are a family owned company who pride themselves on their sustainability and respect for nature. This Sauvignon Blanc comes from the Central Valley region, which allows them to blend wines from the sub-regions of Maipo, Rapel, Curico, and Maule. Such blending enables them to offer incredible value-for-money and consistency. A pleasing pale green colour with yellow hints, this wine evokes a mix of citric fruits such as lemon and lime with gooseberry and a hint of tropical fruit on the nose. The palate is fresh yet balanced with fruit. Pairs well with fish goujons or fried whitebait. Drink now until 2017+.



WHITE WINE (continued)**SL42750 Cousin Macul Isidora Sauvignon Gris 2014, Maipo 13.5% 9.95**

Sauvignon Gris is a rare variety with flavours reminiscent of mango and pink grapefruit. Originally planted in Bordeaux but, like the red varietal Carmenere, the variety did not graft well to American rootstocks, so was not re-planted after the phylloxera crisis. The 'Isidora' Sauvignon Gris has white peach and grapefruit notes on the nose combined with aromas of ginger, anise and a hint of honeysuckle. Tropical fruit flavours on the palate with notes of mango, grapefruit and a touch of spice on the finish. Pair with caramelised onion and goats' cheese tart. Drink now until 2017.

**SL46854 Alto Los Romeros Roussanne/Marsanne 2014, Colchagua Valley 13.5% 9.95**

The Rhone varietals of Marsanne and Roussane have found a new home in the Mediterranean climate of Colchagua Valley. Deep golden yellow in colour. Complex aromas on the nose, with notes reminiscent of peach preserves, ripe pineapple, honey, mandarin and floral hints from the Marsanne. On the palate it is rich and textured with a refreshing acidity, leading to a juicy and long finish. Enjoy with a mildly spicy tagine. Drink now until 2017+.

**SL47724 Signos de Origen 'La Vinilla' 2015, Casablanca Valley 14.5% 11.95**

A Rhone style blend of Chardonnay, Viognier and Marsanne from the coastal appellation, Casablanca Valley. Elegant aromas of apricot, toasted almonds and hints of vanilla. The palate is full and smooth with subtle notes of flowers, luscious lemon meringue fruit and creamy oak with bright natural acidity and a refreshing savoury twist. Perfect with fresh salmon, grilled white fish and seafood. Drink now until 2017+.

**SL46310 Tabali Talinay Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc 2014, Limari Valley 13% 12.99**

Situated in one of the northernmost vineyard regions in Chile, approaching the edge of the Atacama Desert, Tabali commands a unique location on the chalk slopes of the Limari Valley. The region benefits from cooling coastal breezes and mineral-rich soils, which lend restraint and elegance to its wines. On the nose, it displays an alluring perfume of spring flowers, lemons and herbs. A taut palate with well integrated acidity; chalky and herbaceous notes. Pair with Ceviche. Enjoy now until 2018+.

**RED WINE****SL45066 Los Boldos Momentos Syrah 2013, Cachapoal 13.5% 7.99**

The Cachapoal Valley is located between the Maipo and Colchagua valleys in central Chile, and has a temperate Mediterranean climate ideal for red wine production. The Momentos is full of classic Syrah flavours of blackcurrant, plum and spice with hints of cedar and tobacco which complement the fruity character of the wine. Fine tannins add balance and structure. Pair with smoky cheeseburgers. Enjoy now until 2017+.

**SL46714 Los Boldos Tradition Carmenere 2014, Cachapoal 13.5% 8.49**

Carmenere flourishes in its adopted country of Chile, and is perfectly suited to the warm Mediterranean climate of Cachapoal. The Los Boldos Tradition is rich and full-bodied, with notes of spicy blackberry fruit, date and an earthy, savoury twist. Enjoy with Cassoulet. Enjoy now until 2018.

**SL46833 Miguel Torres Chile Reserva del Pueblo Pais 2014, Itata Valley 12% 9.95**

Itata Valley is a cool climate wine region in Chile, located 400 km (250 mi) south of Santiago. The region is notably more rustic and rural than many of Chile's other wine regions, and the varieties grown here reflect Spanish colonisation; the Pais grape was introduced alongside Muscat of Alexandria in the 16th Century. Made in the same way as Beaujolais, the mouthfeel is soft and elegant. Delicate aromas of cherry and red plum follow onto the juicy palate. Delicious served with a light chill. Enjoy with Beef Asada. Drink now until 2017+.

**SL46848 Alto Los Romeros Carignan 2013, Maule Valley 14.5% 9.95**

The Maule Valley, Chile's largest wine region is almost 50km wide and sits between the Andes and the coastal range. The Alto Los Romeros Carignan is an intense bright violet red in colour and shows fresh and intense notes of violets, wild blackberries, and raspberries, which are perfectly harmonised with notes of chocolate and cedar from 12 months aging in French oak. In the mouth it has a pleasing medium body, with round, ripe and juicy tannins and a fresh and persistent finish. Enjoy with red meats. Drink now until 2017+.
