By creating exciting, complex wines, far removed from the simple fruit-bomb reds often associated with the country, Ventisquero proves that Chile is capable of producing outstanding wines that earn their place on the international stage. Established in 1998, Ventisquero has maintained a creative outlook, producing distinctive, high-quality wines from grapes grown in their own vineyards in the Casablanca, Maipo, and Colchagua valleys. Ventisquero has sought to understand the terroir of each area to maximise its potential and to create wines that truly reflect their origins.

Unusual among Chilean producers, all Ventisquero's wine comes from their own vineyards. This has given the winery a boutique and innovative outlook. The team is led by winemaker Felipe Tosso whose experimentation and research have helped to form the house style - sophisticated wines that are distinctively Chilean. Innovation and technological developments have been important to Ventisquero from the start; they use precision agriculture soil mapping techniques to identify 'micro-terroirs' and ensure soils are matched to suitable grape varieties. They are also dedicated to protecting the environment and to sustainable practices keeping the use of chemicals to a minimum, using waste water from the winery for irrigation and planting around existing trees and was the first Chilean winery to voluntarily implement measures to offset carbon dioxide emissions.

#### Clásico

The grapes for Ventisquero's entry-level Clásico range are sourced from across all the winery's vineyards. As Ventisquero only has vineyards in Chile's premium regions the Clásico blends are full-flavoured and offer extremely good value for money.

#### SL36229 Ventisquero Clásico Chardonnay 2012/13, Central Valley, Chile 13.5% £7.99



A fresh, unoaked style of Chardonnay. Light straw colour. Aromas of peach, apricot and minerals with a hint of spice. Ripe stone fruit flavours with mineral acidity and notes of butterscotch. Good weight and balance with

plenty of crisp flavour without appearing fat or over-ripe. An impressive wine, particularly at this price. Great with chicken in a creamy sauce or with fish pie. Enjoy now to 2016.

#### SL36232 Ventisquero Clásico Merlot 2013/14, Central Valley, Chile 13% £7.99

This Merlot exemplifies what the range has to offer.

Deep red in colour with aromas of cherry, plum and exotic spices. Savoury damson, cassis and black cherry with notes of dark chocolate. Fresh and slightly spicy on the lingering finish. Perfect with Italian dishes such as Aubergine Parmigiana, Lasagna or a rich and meaty Spaghetti Bolognese. Enjoy now to 2016/7.



RESERVA

The Reserva range is a step up in quality, with fruit sourced from specific vineyard sites.

**SL34928 Ventisquero Reserva Pinot Grigio 2013, Lolol Valley, Chile 12% £8.99**

Ventisquero have just a small planting of Pinot Grigio vines in the Lolol Valley, a side valley off the Colchagua river and technically within the Colchagua appellation. We felt the style and flavour was more akin to Pinot Gris than Pinot Grigio, but it seems the US market prefers the Grigio name. Light straw colour and vibrant aromas of melon, guava, whitecurrant and lemon grass. Crisp stone fruit intensity with rounded mouthfeel and zesty finish. Good balance with a touch of spice and flinty minerality. This is more of a full-bodied Pinot Gris style than the usual Grigio. Food Match: Japanese-style salmon with noodles and crunchy vegetables, Spaghetti Carbonara or shellfish. Enjoy now to 2017.

**SL44343 Ventisquero Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 2013, Casablanca Valley Chile 12.5% £8.99**

This crystal-clear Reserva Sauvignon Blanc is pale yellow in colour with light green hints. The complex and elegant nose offers up aromas of lime, grapefruit, pineapple and pear complemented by floral and mineral touches. In the mouth it is elegant, with crisp acidity that is typical for this variety. On the palate, more citrus and tropical fruits are evident, with an interesting minerality. Delicious either as an aperitif or as an accompaniment to salads, shellfish, ceviches and fish. It also goes well with white meats and fresh cheeses. Enjoy to 2017.

**SL43655 Ventisquero Reserva Carmenere 2012, Colchagua Valley, Chile 13.5% £8.99**

From vineyards on the slopes of the Colchagua Valley, a sub-region of the Rapel Valley and home to a number of Chile's top producers, this area is particularly noted for its Carmenere and Cabernet. Aged a few months in American oak barrels there is a wonderful balance between fruit, structure, oak and mouthfeel. Deep, relatively youthful colour and attractive aromas of bramble fruits and exotic spices. Ripe plum and blackberry flavours with notes of mocha and vanilla. Supple, accessible and beautifully ripe, this well-priced wine showcases the distinctive character of Carmenere. Delicious with roasted Mediterranean vegetables, Carmenere also pairs really well with lamb dishes and can take a bit of spice, so try with roast lamb, lamb curries or grilled kebabs. Enjoy now to 2017.

**SL38357 Ventisquero Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon 2012, Colchagua Valley, Chile 14% £8.99**

There is 15% Syrah included in this Cabernet for additional aromatic complexity. Both varieties are grown on warmer sites, lower down the valley sides. A third of the wine was left unoaked and the remainder aged 10

months in French barriques. Damson, black cherry and cassis aromas with notes of exotic spices. Initially shows ripe berry fruit flavours on the palate with additional secondary characters emerge, suggesting mocha, woodsmoke and tobacco leaf when the wine opens up in the glass. Medium to full-bodied with plenty of ripe fleshy fruit, gentle savoury tannins and good freshness. A perfect partner to steak or mature Cheddar cheese. An impressive wine to enjoy now or keep to 2018.

GREY

Felipe Tosso makes the Grey range, Ventisquero's premium line which focuses on the concept of terroir. Climate, soil and grape variety combine perfectly to create elegant, balanced wines. Felipe carefully selects single vineyard blocks that are best suited to each specific varietal.

**SL43881 Ventisquero Grey Carmenere 2011, Maipo Valley, Chile 13.5% £13.49**

This Carmenere comes from block no.5 in Ventisquero's Trinidad vineyard. This is situated in the coastal Maipo Valley, Chile's acclaimed region for red wines. This is a wonderful expression of Carmenere, Chile's most unique variety, and shows its character and potential, with 3% Petit Verdot adding complexity. Very deep, almost opaque red/purple colour. Impressively complex aromas of plum, raspberry, sweet vanilla and Asian spices. Full-bodied and flavoursome, the fruit intensity is nicely balanced by fine tannins and integrated acidity. Ripe summer fruit flavours, vanilla hints and very long, lightly spicy finish. A perfect match with venison, roast pork, glazed ham or wild boar sausages. Enjoy now to 2018.

**SL43879 Ventisquero Grey Cabernet Sauvignon 2011/12, Maipo Valley, Chile 14% £13.49**

This Cabernet Sauvignon comes from block no. 38 in the Trinidad vineyard in the Maipo Valley. Felipe Tosso has looked for elegance, ripeness and a character that reflects the origins of the wine and highlights its unique terroir. Blended with just 3% of Petit Verdot the wine is aged 18 months in oak barrels before spending additional time in bottle. Aromas of blackcurrant, raspberry and cranberry jam with hints of pepper and vanilla spice. Generous berry fruit flavours with notes of mocha and a rich, textured mouthfeel. Impressively long, layered finish with fine acidity, chocolatey tannins and an aromatic lift. Bottled with minimal filtration, this is best decanted carefully prior to serving. Enjoy to 2018/19.

ICON**SL43466 Ventisquero Vertice 2008, Apalta Vineyard, Colchagua, Chile 14.5% £21.95**

This Carmenere/Syrah blend is the result of a creative partnership between John Duval (formerly of Penfold's, pictured right with Felipe)

and Felipe. The approach seeks to highlight the best characteristics of each variety, combining them to create something completely new. The grapes are sourced from the highest section of the Fundo Robleria estate in the Apalta Valley, where lot 23 for Carmenere and lot 25 for Syrah intersect at right angles to each other, each with its own distinctive terroir. Fermented and aged 18 months in French oak barriques before blending, the time in barrel is hardly noticeable amidst the rich fruit flavours of the finished wine. Deep, almost opaque garnet colour and plush aromas of ripe plum, blackberry, cherry kirsch, liquorice, ground pepper and a touch of treacle. Full and rich on the palate with intense berry fruit flavours, soft ripe tannins and remarkable freshness. Impressively long finish with a warm, spicy lift. Enjoy to 2017+
